Kristofer Graham Together for NYC

Dear Mr. Graham:

The New York City Campaign Finance Board (the "Board") has completed its review of your independent spending reported during the 2021 election cycle. Two issues were noted.

Two communications—both titled *Russian Targeted Radio Ad*—distributed on 5/21/21 included "Paid for By" notices that were spoken much faster than the content of the advertisement. Board Rules require "Paid for By" notices to be spoken "in a pitch and tone substantially similar to the rest of the communication." The notices make it difficult for the public to ascertain the source of the communication and origin of its funding.

Notwithstanding the above, based on a review of documents submitted and information disclosed during the 2021 election cycle the Board has determined that Together for NYC demonstrated substantial compliance with the New York City Charter and Board Rules.

This concludes our review and a response to this letter is not required. Please retain for three years records of any communication, expenditure, or contribution that you determined was not reportable in case questions arise in the future. Material already submitted need not be retained.
